Decide and Decree

Dr.Giles Croft is a British Psychiatrist! He is also a photographer, writer, and motivational speaker who motivates people to find the right career in life. At the University of Leeds he did an experiment to find out whether people, who believe in the reality of Monday Blues, are more likely to feel blue on Monday.

What Dr. Croft discovered was that the first group which received the report substantiating Monday blues

are more likely to feel blue on Monday.

What Dr. Croft discovered was that the first group which received the report substantiating Monday blues were more likely to rate Monday as being the worst day of the week. From his experiment and research he concluded, "How people expect to feel greatly affects how they will feel.

What you believe is crucial. Beliefs not only affect what you expect to feel, but what you think and do become. Beliefs are the grid we use to interpret life. For many of us, our lives have been structured by what we have been told and taught in the past. The things we read, the things we here, whatever we give our attention to many times, determines how our lives will become. Giving our attention to negative information can have a bad influence on us.

We live in a world which has great impact and influence on our lives. The things we hear through the media, the opinions of others can persuade our thinking and believing and hold us back from how God wants us to freely live. Along with that, what we have experienced in the past; the circumstances we are dealing with now can determine our beliefs, making us think, "*This is the way it is! The flu is coming to town, It'll end us with it too! Que sera sera, whatever will be, will be!*"

The Good News is, it doesn't have to be that way! We don't have to live our lives like a tennis ball on a court being batted back and forth. The Word of God says we can establish and control our own destiny.

Job 22:28 (NIV) Surely you will find delight in the Almighty and will lift up your face to God. You will pray to Him and he will hear you and you will fulfil your vows. What you decide on will be done and light will shine on your ways.

What this passage of scripture tells us, especially what I have highlighted, is that we can "Decide and Decree!" We can decide whether or not Monday is going to be a blue Monday or a good Monday. We can decide what

Job wasn't trusting God, fear and enemy was able to attack him. However, in the midst of all that chaos, Job decreed the goodness of God. As a result, double was restored to Job. He had twice what he possessed before his troubles.

The Apostle Paul said the following – "Rejoice in the Lord always and I say it again, Rejoice! Let your gentleness be evident to all. The Lord is near! Do not worry or be anxious about anything, but in everything with prayer and petition present your petitions to God. And the peace of god which passes all understanding will keep our hearts and minds through Christ. Whatever is true! Whatever is noble! Whatever is right! Whatever is pure! Whatever is lovely! Whatever is admirable! If anything is excellent or praiseworthy, think on these things... And the peace of God will be with you!" – Philippians 4:4 – 8 (NIV)

So don't let the opinions, thoughts and views of others influence your life! Don't let past experiences determine your destiny! Don't let the circumstances determine what the will of God is for your life! God has given us the ability to choose. *Let us choose life so we may live (Deuteronomy 30:19)* So lets make a choice everyday to "Decide and Decree" what our path will be!

Teriyaki Chicken Breasts – Slow Cooker

Ingredients:

- 4 boneless skinless chicken breasts
- 1/2 cup soy sauce
- ¼ cup water
- ¼ cup apple cider vinegar
- 1/4 cup honey
- ¹/₄ cup brown sugar
- 1 tbsp. minced garlic
- 2 tbsp. cornstarch
- rice or quinoa, for serving
- sesame seeds garnish
- sliced green onions garnish



Instructions:

- Lightly spray the slow cooker with non-stick spray.
- Place chicken breasts on bottom of slow cooker.
- Combine soy sauce, vinegar, honey, brown sugar, and garlic in a small bowl and pour over chicken breasts.
- Cook on LOW for 4 hours or until an internal temperature of 165F.
- For shredded chicken, cook on LOW for 6-8 hours. Remove chicken from slow cooker and shred with forks. Set aside.
- Pour sauce into small saucepan and combine cornstarch with water, and add to sauce.
- Over medium heat, bring sauce to a low boil, stirring often, and cook another minute, until sauce is thickened.
- Pour thickened sauce over shredded chicken.
- Serve over rice or quinoa, topped with sesame seeds and sliced green onions.
